		<ul> <li>They could add their names to the current waiting list but, would be at the bottom of that list;</li> </ul>		
		<ul> <li>If it is observed that the first named allotment holder is no longer working the plot the added named persons would be asked to vacate the plot</li> <li>The plot would then be offered to the next person on the waiting list</li> </ul>
